What is included:

- airfare
- Breakfast and Dinner are included
- Personal Tour guide - takes care of everything for us!
- Personal coach (bus) and driver entire trip
- KI Concerts takes care of all of our needs during the entire trip
- Any of our group tours during our sightseeing is covered
- KI also sends a concert person who just takes care of our concert venues and makes sure they are ready to go and if we have any needs.
- Cello/Basses are rented out in Europe for us (violin/viola players bring theirs)

Mrs. Meyers and Mrs. Walters #1 priority are the safe and well being of our students!

- We have a "nurse" (usually Mrs. Walters and a parent) the entire trip who takes care of dispensing meds and any needs of the students.
- All students are assigned a chaperone the entire time. (Students get to sign up for their roommate(s) and groups. Usually, 2-4 students).
- Hotel rooms are usually 2 or 3 single full beds. Students choose their roommate(s)
- Students are not allowed off on their own.
- Routine night checks are done.
- Luggage check is done before we leave to ensure we have everything and to make sure we do not bring things we shouldn't. - this is a standard school trip procedure
- We will need a copy of all med insurance information when the trip gets closer.
- Passports should be obtained as soon as possible. The post office in Grand Haven is a good place. You can get your picture taken at Walgreens that is the correct size.
- Rehearsals for the tour will start in Oct- June and are done one Sunday a month 3-5pm
- We will do a Farewell Concert right before we leave. Usually, this concert is the night before we leave and then we have all our music and instruments packed.
- We try to do one fundraiser each month, starting in end March/April this year
