IMPORTANT: As of the 2001-025 school year the deadline for return of scholarship applications will be strictly enforced. Late and/or incomplete forms will not be honored. ALSO, NO APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ON THIS COMPLETED SCHOLARSHIP FORM. This is for your convenience, as well as the convenience of those involved in implementing the program. It is especially important to have the address that we are to use to send the funds to, as this is often different from the address of the camp.

OBGH summer orchestra scholarships will be sent directly to the campers' home. It has been the tradition of OBGH to give all students the same amount, regardless of the amount of tuitions. This is usually \$50, depending on the number of students applying for scholarships AND the amount of scholarship money available. This amount will vary from year to year.
